

Guidance For PSA Licence Holders Following Latest Public Health Guidelines For County Kildare

The previous guidance note which issued for Counties Kildare, Laois and Offaly has been withdrawn. This guidance note relates to contractors from County Kildare and contractors providing services in County Kildare.

Contractors Resident in County Kildare

Contractors from County Kildare may provide services within the county and in other counties provided the following requirements are met.

- 1. Employees must be provided with appropriate PPE to undertake their duties.
- 2. Employees should receive written instruction on the health and hygiene procedures that have to be followed.
- 3. Contractors and their employees should not travel in groups.
- 4. Contractors and their employees should travel directly to and return from the location of the security service. Stopping at any location other that the site where the security service is to take place is not permitted.
- 5. Contractors and their employees are required to keep a record of all contacts met while providing a security service for contact tracing purposes. A contact is any person who has been interacted with for a period of 10 minutes or more.
- 6. Social distancing should be maintained at all times.

All employees should be encouraged to download the HSE's Covid-19 Tracker App.

Contractors Resident outside of County Kildare

Contractors from outside of County Kildare may provide services within the county provided the following requirements are met.

- 1. Employees must be provided with appropriate PPE to undertake their duties.
- 2. Employees should receive written instruction on the health and hygiene procedures to be followed while working in the county.
- 3. Contractors and their employees should travel directly to and return from the location of the security service. They should not stop at or visit any other location within the county. This includes stops for food, petrol, supplies, etc. These should all be done before visiting County Kildare.
- 4. Contractors and their employees are required to keep a record of all contacts met while providing a security service for contact tracing purposes. A contact is any person who has been interacted with for a period of 10 minutes or more.
- 5. Social distancing should be maintained at all times.

Further information will issue if there is any changes to this guidance.
