

Covid-19, Retailers and the Private Security Industry

Retailers face many new challenges in the post Covid-19 environment including in the area of security. The management of queues outside retail premises will be a feature of our shopping experience for some time to come. It is important to note that retail staff who manage these queues, where these staff also carry out other retail functions, do not require a licence from the PSA. However, retailers who do not use their own retail staff to manage queues must use PSA licensed security guards. The PSA will prosecute retailers and service providers using unlicensed persons in this role.

A number of access control and CCTV products have been launched to manage and control access to shops and other premises. The installation, maintenance and servicing of these products may only be undertaken by the relevant PSA licensed provider. PSA inspectors will be visiting retail outlets to check compliance with this requirement.

Provision of Training Courses to Resume

The PSA have advised training providers that normal training activities can resume from the 1 August 2020.

All training facilities must adhere strictly to public health guidelines around physical distancing and mass gathering restrictions. All participants are urged to take personal responsibility for protecting themselves and others and comply with all public health guidelines. It is important that all necessary requirements requested of them while participating in courses are adhered to in order to continue to suppress the spread of the Covid virus.

Some training providers may include elements of remote training where this has been approved by the PSA in advance. Applicants for courses should refer to our website for a list of approved training providers.

Event Security Update

The licensing of employees in the Event Security sector has been deferred until the 1st March 2021. Licensing had been originally scheduled to take place in March of this year. Further details on licensing will issue in early 2021.

After a number of months desk bound because of Covid-19 restrictions, our inspectors are now back out undertaking investigations and other inspection work. In the first six months of 2020, the PSA has commenced 307 enforcement cases to ensure compliance with the licensing regulations.
