# PSA 67:2021

- **Licensing of Access Control sector in place since 2012**
- **From June Access Control Contractors will require compliance with PSA 67:2021 and PSA 74:2019**
- **Compliance will be audited at next scheduled audit**
- **PSA 67 Standard and associated Auditing Guidelines published on PSA website**

# PSA 67:2021

## Part 1

### Standards Applying To Access Control Sector

- PSA 74:2019
- PSA 67:2021
- EN 60839-11-2
- EN 179
- EN 1125
- EN 13637

**Existing licence holders do not have to comply with EN 60839-11-2 until the 1<sup>st</sup> November 2025**

# PSA 67:2021

## Part 2

**Consists of 7 sections:**

- **Definitions**
- **Grading of Access Points**
- **Location Survey**
- **System Design**
- **Equipment Selection and Installation**
- **Test, Commissioning, Maintenance and Certification**
- **As Fitted Document**

# **PSA 67:2021**

## **EN 60939-11-2**

- **Application Guidelines for Access Control systems**
- **Similar Headings to PSA 67 – Part 2**
- **Apply to all from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2025**

# PSA 67:2021

## EN 179 & EN 1125

- EN 179 - Exit devices operated by lever handle or push pad
- EN 1125 - Exit devices operated by horizontal bars
- EN 13637 systems can only be used in conjunction with EN 179 and/or EN 1125
- EN 13637 systems cannot be used on escape routes in lieu of an EN 179 or EN 1125 system

# **PSA 67:2021**

## **Temporary Licences**

- **Temporary Licence For New Entrants**
- **An average of 60 Temporary Licences for CCTV/Intruder Alarm**
- **Minimum of 2 Access Control installations required**
- **Temporary Licence Duration**

# PSA 67:2021

## Key Points

- **PSA 67 applies from June 2022**
- **Access Control systems must comply with EN 179/EN 1125**
- **Building Regulations paramount – Safety First**
- **Audited at your next scheduled audit**
