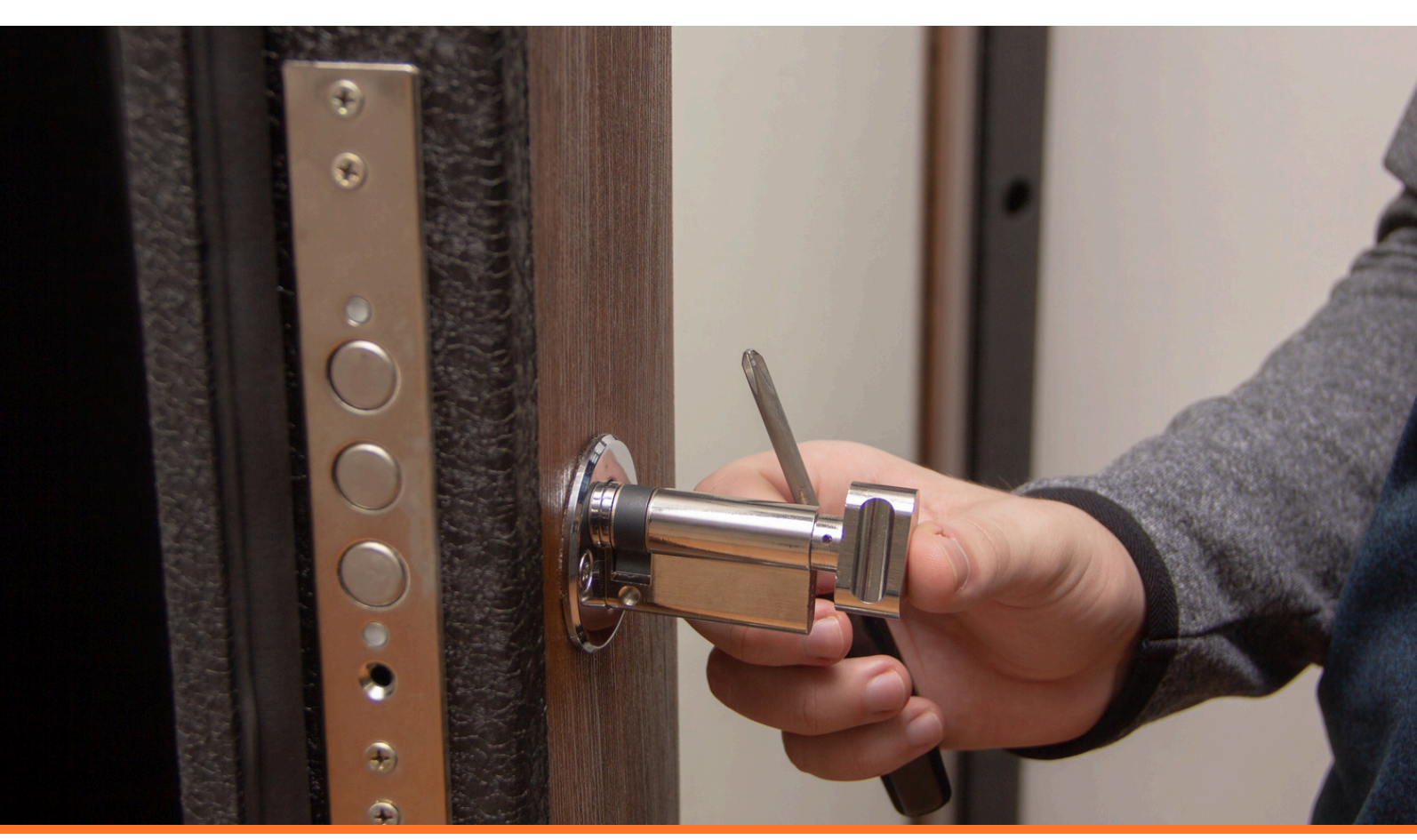


New First Time Application Process

Receiving and Using Your Licence

On approval of your application for a licence, we will issue your Private Security (PSA) identity card along with your licence. Upon receipt, please **carefully check all details on the card**, including your name, photograph, and licence category, to ensure they are correct before using it.

If you identify any **errors** on your identity card or licence, you must **return them immediately** to the PSA with **details of the issue** so it can be resolved.

Please note it is now a requirement that the back of the identity card is signed upon receipt. Licence holders must ensure this is completed before the card is used.
